Day 1: Wednesday, June 19

Coffee Stop, Lunch, & Dinner

Our three-day motor coach adventure will begin with a stop for coffee and a treat on the way to Lincoln. When we arrive in Lincoln we will tour **Memorial Stadium**, the home of the Huskers. We will enjoy lunch at **Lazlo’s Brewery & Grill**. After lunch you will have free time to explore **Lincoln’s Historic Haymarket** which has fun shops & restaurants. We will enjoy dinner and live entertainment at **Screamers Dining & Cabaret**. Then we will check into the creatively designed **Graduate Lincoln Hotel** located in the **Haymarket** area for our two-night stay where you can relax for the rest of the evening.

Day 2: Thursday, June 20

Breakfast, Box Lunch, Treat & Dinner

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and board the motorcoach for a full day of activities beginning with a tour of the historic **Nebraska State Capital**. This National Historic Landmark is so beautiful it was named an architectural world wonder. Our next stop will include a tour with master gardeners at the gorgeous **Sunken Gardens** and the **Hamann Rose Garden**, both known for their exquisite flowers, terraced garden features including art pieces and sculptural elements. Next on the agenda is an escorted driving tour of the **City of Lincoln** while we eat our mini charcuterie boxed lunches “adult Lunchables” from **Grazing Gouda**. Then you will have a choice of touring the **International Quilt Museum** or the **Larson Tractor Museum**. The **International Quilt Museum** houses the world’s largest publicly held quilt collection. The more than 4,500 quilts date from the early 1700s to the present to represent more than 30 countries. **The Larsen Tractor Test & Power Museum** is housed in the original Nebraska Tractor Test Laboratory built in 1920. The collection features tractors that represent advancements in technology which have been tested in accordance with the Nebraska Tractor Test Law. For our afternoon treat we will indulge in delicious ice cream at the **UNL Dairy Store**. To nurture your need for speed we will tour the **Museum of American Speed**. This exhibit is dedicated to preserving and interpreting items significant in racing and automotive history. After dinner at a local restaurant, we will be amused at the **TADA Theatre** where we will see the musical comedy “**Forever Plaid**”.

Day 3: Friday, June 21

Breakfast & Lunch

Our final day of our Lincoln experience begins with a yummy breakfast at the hotel and then a tour of **Robbers Cave**. We will explore Lincoln’s award-winning landmark, the city’s one-and-only underground attraction. Our lunch will be a fun dining experience at **Honest Abe’s Meadowlark**, the home of Honest Abe’s burgers and fries which are topped with normal toppings and reach to the exotic. After lunch we will make our way home with memories of all the fun we had in Lincoln.
