# DAILY ITINERARY

## DAY 1 THURSDAY, JUNE 10 FAIRBANKS

Our journey to Alaska begins as we board our comfortable motorcoach to Sioux Falls, where we take flight to **Fairbanks**, the gateway to Alaska's wild and captivating interior. Upon arrival, we are welcomed and transferred to **SpringHill Suites by Marriott Fairbanks** (or similar), giving us time to relax and settle in. Then, gather with our tour manager for a warm introduction and a preview of the incredible experiences ahead.

## DAY 2 FRIDAY, JUNE 11 DENALI (B, L)

A breathtaking drive leads us toward **Denali**, where a delicious group lunch awaits. Later, embark on the renowned **Tundra Wilderness Tour within Denali National Park**, guided by an expert naturalist. As we traverse this vast, untamed landscape, keep watch for grizzly bears, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, and other native species roaming freely. Throughout our exploration, we'll discover the area's captivating past, remarkable landforms, and delicate balance of habitats that make this region unlike anywhere else. Tonight, we will stay at the cozy **Denali Park Village** (or similar).

## DAY 3 SATURDAY, JUNE 12 TALKEETNA (B, L)

Spend the morning at your leisure before we make our way to the rail depot to **board a deluxe dome railcar**, settling in beneath expansive glass ceilings for a memorable journey toward Talkeetna. As we travel through ever-changing scenery, enjoy a delicious lunch while taking in views of winding waterways, forested landscapes, and soaring mountain peaks. Once we arrive in **Talkeetna** and check into **Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge** (or similar), you'll have the afternoon and evening free to wander and enjoy this charming town at your own pace.

## DAY 4 SUNDAY, JUNE 13 ANCHORAGE (B)

Adventure awaits as we set out on a **thrilling jet boat excursion** through the wild landscapes surrounding Talkeetna, skimming across shallow waterways with exhilarating spins before slowing to take in the quiet beauty of the backcountry. Along the way, watch for moose, bald eagles, and bears while enjoying sweeping views of the Alaska Range. After free time for lunch, visit a local musher's kennel to **learn about the legendary Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race** and **meet the remarkable sled dogs** behind it. The night is free to enjoy at our own pace, with dinner on our own before settling in at **Hilton Anchorage** (or similar).

## DAY 5 MONDAY, JUNE 14 WHITTIER (B, L, D)

A scenic drive carries us south through striking mountain landscapes to the coastal town of Whittier, with a stop at the **Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center** to view bears, moose, bison, and wolves up close. Upon arrival, **board the Norwegian Jade** and begin our unforgettable seven-night voyage through Alaska's stunning shoreline.

## DAY 6 TUESDAY, JUNE 15 CRUISE HUBBARD GLACIER (B, L, D)

Get up close and personal with the gigantic **Hubbard Glacier**, North America's largest tidewater glacier. It is 1,350 square miles of blue ice and one of the most active glaciers in Alaska! Calving occurs nearly every day, an exciting experience that sends large chunks of ice crashing into the water below.

## DAY 7 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 16 ICY STRAIT POINT (B, L, D)

Venture "where the north wind doesn't blow." Known for this famous saying, **Icy Strait Point** is the ideal landing spot for adventurers seeking a new experience. Breathtaking and exciting, Icy Strait Point truly takes you where the wild things are. It's one of the few places in the world where wildlife outnumbers the human population. While in port, optional excursions include experiencing a traditional Tlingit tribal performance and getting up close to humpback whales and brown bears in the wild. Work up a wilderness hunger and satisfy it with fresh Dungeness crab, or take in Alaska's awe-inspiring landscapes by gondola, tram, ATV, kayak, or high-speed boat.

## DAY 8 THURSDAY, JUNE 17 JUNEAU (B, L, D)

We are off to **Juneau**, which has been called "Alaska's peak experience," undoubtedly due in part to its unparalleled glacier viewing from such places as Tracy Arm Fjord, the Juneau Icefields, and Glacier Bay National Park. Optional excursions in Juneau include kayaking up one of the area's many protected waterways, embarking on a whale-watching adventure, feasting on salmon, touring historic downtown, or trying one's hand at panning for gold.

**DAY 9 FRIDAY, JUNE 18****SKAGWAY****(B, L, D)**

The great Klondike Gold Rush lives on in Skagway's charming downtown, featuring restored nineteenth-century buildings and its historic railway. Located on the edge of the wilderness, this small town saw its fair share of gold seekers. Today, there is so much fascinating history to uncover in **Skagway!**

**DAY 10 SATURDAY, JUNE 19****KETCHIKAN (WARD COVE)****(B, L, D)**

Known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World,' **Ketchikan** is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit people, who have carved the world's largest collection of totem poles. Next to the water, you'll find the neat row of wooden buildings known as Creek Street. Today, they are brightly painted boutiques, but their history tells a different story!

**DAY 11 SUNDAY, JUNE 20****CRUISE INSIDE PASSAGE****(B, L, D)**

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as we sail through the islands of **Alaska's Inside Passage**. This complex labyrinth of fjords, bays, and lush green islands is home to an abundance of wildlife, including orcas, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters, and much more.

**DAY 12 MONDAY, JUNE 21****HOME****(B)**

We disembark in **Vancouver, British Columbia**, and catch our flight home.
